SPARKLING WHITE

\$28 Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir

France (Champagne)

Champagne Collet Aÿ Brut, NV

Champagne Collet Brut is the distinctive cuvee and identity of Maison Collet, harmoniously combining Champagne's three main grape varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. Light golden-amber color. Toasted brioche aromas with fine citrus notes. Powerful and full-bodied revealing great freshness and amazing length.

\$16 Chardonnay New Mexico (Albuquerque)

Gruet Blanc de Blanc, NV

Gruet Blanc de Blancs is a Brut styled sparkler, medium lemon in color with a fantastic bead in the glass that remains incredibly lively throughout the palate. Aromas of intense notes of brioche, followed by green apples, lemon zest, honeysuckle, and tropical fruit. Soft on the front of the palate with nice lingering acidity on the finish. Flavors of fresh green apple and pineapple with great structure from top to bottom.

\$13 Glera

Italy (Valdobbiadene)

Bortolomiol Prosecco Valdobbiadene Superiore Extra Dry, NV

In the glass it has a straw-yellow color, with some light reflections tending to gold and greenish. The perlage is thin and persistent. The aromas on the nose recount fruity and citrus scents, which blend well with notes of lily of the valley, hawthorn and aromatic herbs. Tasting is balanced, soft, extremely drinkable.

\$14 Mourvèdre South Africa (Swartland)

Intellego 'Hey Mila!' Pét-Nat Rosé, 2024

A glorious salmon pink petillant naturel made from 100% Mourvedre. Mila is Jurgen's wife's niece and her bubbly personality as a 2.5 year old struck him when they stayed with them pre-wedding. Apart from hearing his wife complain about his style, her brother calling 'Hey Mila' was something he heard often and it grew on him to name this sparkling wine after her.

\$10 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

HoneyBubbles, NV

The palate offers bubbling mousse flourishing with sweet citrus and tangerine, honey, peaches, white flowers and orange zest on the finish. The wine has an intriguing balance of sweetness and acidity providing structure.

\$12 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

Vietti, NV

An intense aroma of ripe yellow fruit (peaches, apricots, pears), floral notes (rose petals) and refined exotic spices (freshly cut ginger). The sweetness is balanced with a crisp, and refreshing acidity.

SPARKLING ROSE/RED

\$13 Syrah Washington (Columbia Valley)

Treveri Sparkling Syrah Brut, NV

This one-of-a-kind wine combines rich flavors of blackberry, pepper, cherries, and a hint of tobacco for a dark and delicious treat that is all its own. Deep red color with an effervescence sure to delight, our Syrah brings together dark cherries, tobacco, and spice for a rich, flavorful finish.

\$19 Pinot Noir France (Jura)

Domaine Désiré Cremant de Jura Brut Rose, NV

Domaine Désiré Petit Crémant du Jura Brut Rosé is a super-limited, 100% Pinot Noir sparkling wine from the Jura region of eastern France. Cultivated from organic vineyards in Pupillin and Arbois, it delivers elegant aromas of red berries, orange zest, and a bone-dry, creamy finish.

\$13 Malvasia di Schierano, Malvasia Lunga Nero (Off-dry, pink/red)

Italy (Piedmont)

Bava Rosetta, Malvasia Di Castelnuovo Don Bosco, NV

Cherry red in color with a little crown. Bouquet of wild rose and strawberries, sweet and balanced while the tannins are just slightly perceptible leaving intact the pleasantness of the wine. Natural and lively with a balanced palate.

STILL WHITE

\$12 Melon de Bourgogne

France (Loire Valley)

Domaine de La Chauvinière, Muscadet Sèvre et Maine sur lie, NV

Crisp and elegant, Domaine de La Chauvinière Muscadet Sèvre et Maine captures the classic

freshness of the Loire Valley. Made from Melon de Bourgogne grapes, it shows pale straw color with delicate aromas of citrus, green apple, and a touch of sea breeze. On the palate, it's light and vibrant with bright acidity, subtle minerality, and a clean, refreshing finish.

\$17 Greco Bianco, Falanghina, Fiano California (Napa Valley)

Massican Gemina, 2023

Gemina is the name of an ancient Roman grape planted in the region around the Massican hills of southern Italy. This grape variety originates from Greece, dating back to the first century when it was first called Aminea Gemina. It is super crisp, acidic, and mouth-puckering, with intense lemon, lime, grapefruit, and green apple flavors accented by minerals and white pepper.

\$17 Sauvignon Blanc California (Paso Robles) **ONX Field Day Sauvignon Blanc, 2023**

A refreshing and serious vintage of Sauvignon Blanc, cooler weather and long growing season lead to a great deal of restraint and nuance. A mix of bright green apple and sea salt intermingle with dry grass, gooseberry, and candied banana in an understated medley along with cocktail notes like lemon drop and an herbal vermouth bite. The wine hits softly on the entry with understated acid and notes of green

bananas and fresh kiwi before acid develops along with bright pineapple notes, orange zest, and lime juice.

\$12 Semillon, Malvasia of Lazio Italy (Lazio)

Appia Antica 400, Lazio Bianco I.G.T., 2022

The wine is brilliant, with a beautiful straw yellow color. Consistent on the nose, very intense, complex, with fruity notes of pear and citrus, exotic and floral fruit. On the palate it is dry, fresh, rightly acid with a typical flavor and minerality of the territory, persistent in the mouth, intense, harmonious and elegant. The Semillon finds in these volcanic territories a very particular personality That it allows to best express its mineral and fresh characteristics.

\$18 Chardonnay Argentina (Mendoza)

Zorzal Gran Terroir Chardonnay, 2022

This boutique, sustainably farmed Chardonnay presents a complex mineral profile with notes of crushed wet rock, green apple, orange peel, and subtle hints of baked bread. It is fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged for 12 months in 500L French oak barrels and concrete.

STILL ROSE & ORANGE (SKIN-CONTACT)

\$13 Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah, Rolle France
(Provence)

Chateau Gassier Provence Rosé, 2024

Pale color with white nectarine highlights. On the nose, notes of white-eshed fruit (peach, nectarine), citrus (Corsican clementine) and exotic fruit and balanced on the palate between tension and roundness, with delicate notes of white-eshed fruit and citrus zest.

\$17 Flame Tokay

California (Sebastopol)

Monte Rio Cellars, Flame Tokay Heirloom Ranch, 2024

This bottle is a history lesson on original grapes grown in California. There are not many vines left in the state, but at one time, Flame Tokay was all the rage and was planted everywhere. Most white wine bottlings were this varietal. It was a hearty grape and grew almost anywhere. The aromas are lively with orange blossom, pear, citrus, and honeycomb notes on the nose.

CORAVIN REDS

\$30 Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Merlot Beaulieu Vineyard, Tapestry Reserve Red

A layered and lightly chewy red with currant, orange peel and hints of hazelnut. Fine tannins. Some pine, cedar, graphite, black currant and iodine. Perfumed. Tannins turn fine and bright. Excellent length and

serious tension.

\$24 Merlot, Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon **Ornellaia estate, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia, 2021**

With its signature ruby red hue and purple tinges, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia displays lively red fruit aromas alongside light spiciness. The wine is well balanced across all components on the palate, blending smooth tannins with refreshing acidity that lends crunchiness to this enjoyable wine

STILL RED

\$12 Mavrud, Rubin Bulgaria (Thracian Valley) **CHILLED!**

Edoardo Miroglio, Bio Red Blend, NV

Intense and vivid ruby colour. Complex and fresh fruity nose with red fruit nuances: blackcurrant, cherry and blackberry, elegantly balanced with the oak.

Distinctive typical aromas of the indigenous grape varieties. The taste is elegant and well balanced. Rich fruity flavour, well balanced acidity and tannins.

\$14 Carmenere

Chile (Valle de Colchagua)

Baron Philippe de Rothschild, Escudo Rojo **Gran Reserva, 2022**

The nose opens on ripe blackberry fruit aromas, joined on airing by notes of roasted coffee beans and black

pepper. From a highly expressive attack on the black fruit found on the nose, the peppery notes that emerged with airing return on a midpalate which combines power with heft. The finish lingers on an intense array of black fruit, spice, and roasted coffee bean flavors.

\$16 Pinot Noir California (Russian River Valley)
Selby Russian River Valley Pinot Noir, 2023

Indulge in the exquisite flavors of Selby 2023 Pinot Noir from Russian River, Sonoma, California. This elegant wine boasts a deep ruby hue with a hint of black rim, promising a rich and velvety taste that will tantalize your taste buds.

\$13 Barbera, Dolcetto, Cabernet Sauvignon Italy
(Piemonte)

Buongiorno Tacchino Rosso, 2019

Dark cherry, cranberry, and slate on the nose are joined by hints of white blossom and smoke. The palate boasts well-integrated acidity and bright, delicious fruit (drinking more like a 13% wine than the 14% listed) with a pleasing, long-lasting finish.

\$17 Grenache

California (Amador County)

Emme Wines, Qu'est-ce que signifie:éphémère?, 2021

Grenache from Shake Ridge Ranch in Amador County run by esteemed grower Ann Kraemer. This is a new variety & vineyard for Rosalind. The label translates to 'what does it mean: ephemeral?,' a line from Le Petit Prince by Antoine Saint-Exupery. Wild strawberries, brambly spice, delicate tannins.

\$14 Malbec Argentina (Mendoza)

Familia Furlotti, Vino Tinto Malbec, 2017

Medium in intensity and body, this Syrah shines with aromas of tobacco and herbaceous notes of olive and clove. Flavors of blackberry, black cherry, and more notably hot cedar sauna are stunning on the mid-palate. Coffee, tobacco, and earthy notes round out the back of the palate.

\$15 Cabernet Sauvignon

France (Languedoc)

Famille Fabre, Equilibrium Cabernet Sauvignon, 2022

Licorice, blackberry, and tangy spice explode in the nose, while this fresh red gives a soft yet exciting mouth-feel full of black cherry, juicy blackberry, clove, and black pepper.

Blood Orange Spritz

\$12/\$22 Pitcher

Lively and bittersweet with vibrant orange peel, herbs, and citrus zest. Fine bubbles lift bright botanicals, finishing crisp, slightly tart, and refreshingly dry. Classic aperitivo elegance.

Porto Tónico

A bright and breezy highball from the Douro to the Aegean. Crisp dry white port meets the delicate salinity and botanicals of Three Cents' Aegean Tonic for a refreshingly elegant aperitif with a coastal twist. Light, zesty, and effortlessly cool.
