## SPARKLING WHITE

**\$28 Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir**

France (Champagne)

## **Champagne Collet Aÿ Brut, NV**

Champagne Collet Brut is the distinctive cuvee and identity of Maison Collet, harmoniously combining Champagne's three main grape varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. Light golden-amber color. Toasted brioche aromas with fine citrus notes. Powerful and full-bodied revealing great freshness and amazing length.

**\$14 Macabeu, Xarel-lo, Ugni Blanc** Mexico  
(Querétaro)

## **Baijo, Sparkling Brut, NV**

A lively sparkling bursting with aromas of Meyer lemon, jasmine, pear, and hints of brioche. The palate is fresh and dry with notes of white flowers, apples, bright acidity and a persistent finish.

**\$17 Folle Blanche, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay** France  
(Loire)

## **Jo Landron, Atmospheres, Cremant de Loire, NV**

Composed of 55% Folle Blanche and 25% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir, the blend changes with each release depending on which grapes Jo Landron selects. If AOC rules allowed it, this would be called "Sparkling Muscadet." It's a zesty, refreshing and razor-sharp bubbly from a biodynamic producer just outside Nantes. Hand-harvested, wild yeast, méthode traditionnelle, aged 24 months on lees. Zero dosage. A

lot going on here: get ripe, fresh lime zest, white flowers, almond, hazelnut, brioche and wet stone.

**\$19 Sumoll** Spain (Pendes)

**Clos Lentiscus, Blanc de Noirs Brut Nature , NV**

Subtle notes of red fruits and well integrated bubbles which is very pleasant on the palate. Delicate and gentle structure. All yeasts involved in the two fermentations are indigenous. Then the second fermentation is aged for 72 months on the lees in the bottle.

**\$10 Moscato** Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

**HoneyBubbles, NV**

The palate offers bubbling mousse flourishing with sweet citrus and tangerine, honey, peaches, white flowers and orange zest on the finish. The wine has an intriguing balance of sweetness and acidity providing structure.

**\$12 Moscato** Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

**Vietti, NV**

An intense aroma of ripe yellow fruit (peaches, apricots, pears), floral notes (rose petals) and refined exotic spices (freshly cut ginger). The sweetness is balanced with a crisp, and refreshing acidity.

## **SPARKLING ROSE**

### **\$18 Macabeu, Perellada, Monastrell** Spain

(Penedes)

#### **Raventós i Blanc, Cava Rosé de Nit**

Rose "De Nit" is made from the classic white Cava grapes with a tiny bit of red Monastrell for color and aromatic effect. The salmon hued wine is razor sharp on the palate with hints of red fruit and citrus salt.

### **\$12 Lambrusco Grasparossa, Pinot Nero**

Italy (Castelvetro)

#### **Cleto Chiarli "Rosé de Noir" Brut Vino Spumante, NV**

Fragrances of wild raspberry, red currant, red strawberry that fill the glass. Vivacious, buoyant and persistent mousse that is tiny yet still holds a nice texture to the palate, wild red berry fruits permeate throughout and lively finish. A wine to be enjoyed over and over again.

### **\$13 Malvasia di Schierano, Malvasia Lunga Nero (Off-dry, pink/red)**

Italy (Piedmont)

#### **Bava Rosetta, Malvasia Di Castelnuovo Don Bosco, NV**

Cherry red in color with a little crown. Bouquet of wild rose and strawberries, sweet and balanced while the

tannins are just slightly perceptible leaving intact the pleasantness of the wine. Natural and lively with a balanced palate.

## **STILL WHITE**

### **\$14 Trebbiano, Grechetto, Malvasia**

Italy (Tuscany)

#### **Poggio del Moro, Ivole Toscana Bianco, 2024**

On the nose, a fresh, crisp bouquet of plum, pear, and melon along with a touch of nuttiness. Lighthearted, mineral notes of wildflowers and herbs linger on the palate towards a finish that sparkles with hints of lemon and orange.

### **\$17 Arneis** California (Yorkville Highlands)

#### **Idlewild, Arneis Lost Hills Ranch, 2019**

The wine is fermented via native yeast in stainless steel after a whole cluster pressing. Secondary fermentation and aging for four months in neutral oak on lees adds texture and complexity that are counterbalanced by being sure to pick while the acidity is still racy and pure.

### **\$19 Sauvignon Blanc** California (Napa)

#### **Amulet Estate, 2024**

The AE Sauvignon Blanc bursts out of the glass with aromatics of lemon curd, honeysuckle, wet stone and juicy stone fruit. In the mouth spirited acidity is met by

flavors of fresh white peach, golden apple, savory herbs and pastry cream balanced by clean minerality all giving way to a long mouthwatering finish.

**\$17 Roussanne, Chardonnay** USA (California)  
**Stolpman Vineyards, Uni, 2021**

This wine is crisp and zippy, but with a full, creamy texture. Bursting with green apple, stone fruit, and marine minerality, this is the perfect companion for sushi.

**\$17 Chardonnay** France (Clessé)

**Chanson, Viré-Clessé, Côte d'Or, 2022**

Chanson Pere & Fils Vire Clesse is a pale gold color. Delicate fragrances of fern mixed with citrus fruit on a hint of minerality. Well balanced and precise. Tense with a very pure fruit combination. Refreshing finish with mineral tinges.

**STILL ROSE & ORANGE (SKIN-CONTACT)**

**\$14 Pinot Noir** USA (Oregon, Eola-Amity)

**Violet Vines, Rosé of Pinot Noir, 2024**

This “year round” Rose is filled with extra color, structure and lush tropical fruit and florals making it the perfect Rose to drink in any season of the year. Flavors of Rainier cherry, bright watermelon, and papaya unite with a perfumed bouquet of rose petals on the palate.

**\$16 Grasevina, Pinot Blanc**

## **SoHu, Dry Skin Contact Orange Wine**

The result is a lively, fleshy and deliciously quaffable skin contact wine! SoHu Orange delivers beautiful and lush aromas of fleshy peach skin, orange blossom and lemon drops, while the palate delivers nice acidity but still bursting with ripe flavors of peach, apricot, and carried off with a pleasant herbal finish.

## **CORAVIN REDS**

### **\$30 Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Merlot**

#### **Beaulieu Vineyard, Tapestry Reserve Red**

A layered and lightly chewy red with currant, orange peel and hints of hazelnut. Fine tannins. Some pine, cedar, graphite, black currant and iodine. Perfumed. Tannins turn fine and bright. Excellent length and serious tension.

### **\$24 Merlot, Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon Ornellaia estate, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia, 2021**

With its signature ruby red hue and purple tinges, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia displays lively red fruit aromas alongside light spiciness. The wine is well balanced across all components on the palate, blending smooth tannins with refreshing acidity that lends crunchiness to this enjoyable wine

## STILL RED

**\$19 Teroldego, Barbera** USA (Colorado)

**CHILLED!**

**Aquila Cellars, Lettuce Crush Vol. 1, 2022**

A collaboration between Colorado natural winery Aquila Cellars and funk band Lettuce. It's a spin on traditional Italian table wine. Fermented 50% whole-cluster and barrel aged for 10 months in neutral oak, this wine delivers powerful red and black fruits from the Barbera, followed by savory black olive notes from the Teroldego, a grape traditionally grown in the high Dolomites of Italy. Its high country meets low country for this uncommon blend. Great for a table of friends and family but with enough high-acid zing to crush while the notes rise and the beats pump

**\$18 Alvarelhão, Tinta Pinheira, Touriga Nacional, Jaen, Tinta Amarela**

Portugal (Dão)

**Quinta de Pellada, Naked Vine, 2018**

This is elegant and complex, with moderate tannins and lush texture. The finish is long and persistent, even while nothing is harsh or astringent. This is a beauty that is hard to resist. It will also age well, maybe better than indicated.

**\$17 Pinot Noir** Oregon (Willamette Valley)

**Violet Vines, Pinot Noir, 2023**

A fruit and citrus combination that reminded me of a blueberry scone sprinkled with orange zest was accompanied by a worn leather note. Sandy tannins that rub the roof of the mouth the right way surround flavors of boysenberries, bitter cacao nibs and an herbal one-two punch of sage and thyme.

## **\$16 Sangiovese** Italy (Chianti)

### **Cafaggio, Chianti Classico Riserva, 2019**

Cherries, raspberries and chocolate are contrasted with metallic, earthy notes of pencil shavings and soil on the nose, with the graphite aromas providing a through line to a palate that's almost quartz-like with salty, acidic notes and the snap of fresh cherry skin.

## **\$13 Grenache Noir, Syrah, Mourvedre**

France (Rhône Valley)

### **Domaine Gabriel Monier, Cotes du Rhone**

Ruby red color. The aromas come in waves of wild blackberry, a hint of cranberry and then earth. Well balanced full body. More rich berry flavors, a little oak and then hints of soy sauce.

## **\$13 Vranec**

Macedonia (Tikves)

### **Jordanov, Vranec, 2022**

Indigenous to North Macedonia, Serbia and Montenegro, Vranec is a thick-skinned grape with high tannins and medium-high acidity. The word itself translates as ‘Black Stallion’ owing to its forceful character and rich coloring. This lip-smacking rendition of this East European classic is farmed “high and dry”, in rich clay soils that support its vibrancy and overall bone structure. Deep, dark ruby color offering Dusty earth and cherry pie aromas on the nose. The palate presents full, concentrated fruit with brambly tannins with a soft but lingering finish.

## **\$15 Cabernet Sauvignon**

California (Napa Valley)

### **Tuck Bestoffer, The 1975, NV**

Aromas of black cherry, fresh plum, and dried sage mingle with subtle notes of vanilla and anise. On the palate, layers of green peppercorn, tobacco leaf, and cedar add complexity. Firm tannins and balanced acidity lead to a long, refined finish.

## **Wine Spritzers**

### **Blood Orange Spritz**

#### **\$12/\$22 Pitcher**

Lively and bittersweet with vibrant orange peel, herbs, and citrus zest. Fine bubbles lift bright

botanicals, finishing crisp, slightly tart, and refreshingly dry. Classic aperitivo elegance.

## **Porto Tónico**

### **\$13/\$24 Pitcher**

A bright and breezy highball from the Douro to the Aegean. Crisp dry white port meets the delicate salinity and botanicals of Three Cents' Aegean Tonic for a refreshingly elegant aperitif with a coastal twist. Light, zesty, and effortlessly cool.
