SPARKLING WHITE

\$28 Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir

France (Champagne)

Champagne Collet Aÿ Brut, NV

Champagne Collet Brut is the distinctive cuvee and identity of Maison Collet, harmoniously combining Champagne's three main grape varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. Light golden-amber color. Toasted brioche aromas with fine citrus notes. Powerful and full-bodied revealing great freshness and amazing length.

\$20 Chardonnay, Pinot Noir California (Mendocino County)

Roederer Estate Brut, NV

Roederer Estate Brut is crisp and elegant sparkling wine with complex pear, spice and hazelnut flavors. Oak-aged wines from our estate's reserve cellars are added to this blend, creating a multi-vintage cuvée that has great finesse and depth of flavor.

\$15 Macabeo, Parellada

Spain (Vila-Rodona)

Castell D'Or Flama Roja Brut Cava, NV

Crafted in Spain's renowned Cava region, Flama Roja Cava Brut Nature delivers pure, unadulterated sparkle with no dosage to mask its character. A traditional-method blend of Macabeo and Parellada grapes yields crisp green apple, citrus zest, and delicate floral notes, framed by fine, persistent bubbles.

\$13 Riesling Slovenia (Dobrovnik)

Gönc 'Wine Duedes', Skin Contact Pet-Nat, 2021

Delicate orange zest and cinnamon flavors combined with tropical fruits slowly move into the nutty, yeasty flavors to a round and deep finish. Rich and creamy texture as a result of skin contact and malolactic fermentation with wild bubbles on top.

\$12 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.) **Vietti, NV**

An intense aroma of ripe yellow fruit (peaches, apricots, pears), floral notes (rose petals) and refined exotic spices (freshly cut ginger). The sweetness is balanced with a crisp, and refreshing acidity.

\$10 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)
HoneyBubbles, NV

The palate offers bubbling mousse flourishing with sweet citrus and tangerine, honey, peaches, white flowers and orange zest on the finish. The wine has an intriguing balance of sweetness and acidity providing structure.

SPARKLING ROSE/RED

\$16 Lambrusco Salamino Italy (Emilia)
Lambrusco "Solco", Paltrinieri, 2025

A dark, fruity, red sparkling wine that's made from the Lambrusco Salamino grape variety. The grapes were macerated on the skins for two days before fermenting in tank via the Martinotti, or Charmat method. A wine to drink with starters or pizza. The Paltrinieri winery is now run by fourth generation winemaker Alberto and Barbara Paltrinieri.

\$19 Chardonnay, Pinot Noir California (Napa Valley)
Schramsberg, Mirabelle Brut Rosé, 2021

The Mirabelle Rosé has generous aromas of strawberry, raspberry, kumquat and rhubarb. Notes of apricot, red plum, shortbread and cinnamon delicately

join the bursting flavors of red apple and watermelon on the palate. Juicy on entry, this Rosé's bright acidity leads to a long, lingering finish.

\$13 Malvasia di Schierano, Malvasia Lunga Nero (Off-dry, pink/red)

Italy (Piedmont)

Bava Rosetta, Malvasia Di Castelnuovo Don Bosco, NV

Cherry red in color with a little crown. Bouquet of wild rose and strawberries, sweet and balanced while the tannins are just slightly perceptible leaving intact the pleasantness of the wine. Natural and lively with a balanced palate.

STILL WHITE

\$16 Palomino California (Cucamonga Valley) **Scythian Wine Co., Cucamonga Revolution, 2023**

100% Palomino from the Lopez Vineyard, planted in 1912 on sandy granite soil. The grapes are hand-harvested, direct pressed and fermented in neutral barrels. The wine rests under flor for several months in used sherry casks from Ramiro Ibanez. Bottled unfined, unfiltered with a small amount of SO₂ at bottling.

\$16 Carricante Italy (Sicily)

Cottanera Etna Bianco, NV

This Etna Bianco DOC is straw-coloured. On the nose has citrus notes of lemon and cedar mixed with orange blossom and jasmine. On the palate it is full bodied but well supported by the acidity that gives the tasting a rare persistent freshness.

\$11 Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand (Marlborough) **Sam's Creek Sauvignon Blanc, 2024**

This wine offers an authentic expression of cooler-climate Sauvignon Blanc. Its bright natural acidity is juicy and thirst-quenching, while complex aromatics and lifted flavors of grapefruit and citrusy lime are accented beautifully by wet stone minerality. The elegant, textured mouthfeel leads to a clean, crisp finish.

\$16 Grechetto Italy (Umbria)

Romanelli Fonte Perna Grechetto, 2023

The nose is expressive and layered, opening with floral aromas of chamomile and hawthorn, followed by yellow peach, honeydew melon, pineapple and lemon zest. With aeration, subtle toasted hazelnut notes and delicate mineral nuances emerge, adding depth and complexity. On the palate, the wine shows a medium to full body with a slightly creamy texture, balanced by lively acidity. Flavours of citrus peel, yellow fruit and mineral tones unfold with precision, supported by a refined structure. The finish is fresh, persistent and

gently nutty, leaving a long impression of citrus and minerality.

\$15 Chardonnay California (Napa Valley)

The Terraces, 392 Cases Chardonnay, 2019

Pale lemon green hue with aromas of lemon grass, white pear, ripe pineapple, passion fruit, and vanilla. The mouthfeel is incredibly rich with surprising weight but is balanced with bright acidity. This wine complex flavors of passion fruit, pineapple, guava, lemon zest, and hints of vanilla with a lingering finish.

STILL ROSE & ORANGE (SKIN-CONTACT)

\$15 Blaufrankish, Pinot Noir, Žametna Crnina

Slovenia (Štajerska)

Grape Abduction Co. Rosé, 2023

Pale pink, with aromas of wild strawberry, raspberry, red cherry, and a hint of violet. Round and fruity on the palate, with strawberry, red currant, and watermelon over a soft mid-palate. Refreshing acidity keeps it clean and lively through the finish.

\$14 Škrlet

Croatia (Moslavina)

Vinarija Voštinić Klasnić Škrlet, 2023

Škrlet is typically a clear and of light yellow color, with higher acidity and low alcohol, making it light, playful, refreshing, and easy to drink. It is rich with flowery aromas, herbal notes and often delivers a palate of

pineapple, peaches and apples. This wine is a spring or summer day packed into a bottle, exploding with versatile flavors and aromas. Škrlet is a bright beam of sunshine wherever you may find the need.

CORAVIN REDS

\$30 Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Merlot Beaulieu Vineyard, Tapestry Reserve Red

A layered and lightly chewy red with currant, orange peel and hints of hazelnut. Fine tannins. Some pine, cedar, graphite, black currant and iodine. Perfumed. Tannins turn fine and bright. Excellent length and serious tension.

\$24 Merlot, Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon Ornellaia estate, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia, 2021

With its signature ruby red hue and purple tinges, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia displays lively red fruit aromas alongside light spiciness. The wine is well balanced across all components on the palate, blending smooth tannins with refreshing acidity that lends crunchiness to this enjoyable wine

STILL RED

\$12 Arneis, Dolcetto, Barbera, Nebbiolo California
(Mendocino Valley)

CHILLED!

Ruth Lewandoski, Feints, 2024

Translucent ruby with a light, violet-tinged edge. The nose is bright and expressive, with fresh cranberry, raspberry, dried herbs, and a floral lift from the Arneis. The palate is light-bodied and juicy, with brisk acidity, a soft tannic grip, and a clean, refreshing finish.

\$17 Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cunoise, Cinsaut California (Santa Barbara)

Margerum Wine Company M5, 2023

M5 is Margerum's Flagship wine. It is modeled after top wines from southern Rhône –
Châteauneuf-du-Pape . The M is for Margerum and the 5 is for 5 grapes: Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault, and Cunoise. M5 is a Grenache-based blend and has elegance and layers making it a versatile table and food wine. The overlying presence of Grenache flavors initially impacts the palate, followed by a finish complete with hints of jam, cocoa, and dark berry contributions of Syrah and earthy Mourvèdre. It's a “go-to” wine since it drinks well with every occasion and almost every type of cuisine.

\$16 Pinot Noir, Gamay Noir Oregon (Willamette)
Evening Lands Vineyards, Eola-Amity Hills, 2024

Cranberry-ruby in the glass, this is a wine of lifted fruit and flowers; Morello cherry, blood orange, hibiscus and fresh raspberry come to mind. Fresh, light-bodied, a flash of spice on the palate adds zip to what is an immensely drinkable wine with a polished finish. There is no hiding the energy of the cool climate Eola-Amity Hills here.

\$17 Sangiovese Italy (Toscana)

Il Palazzo, Cum Sanguis, Sangiovese, 2018

A pure, expressive take on Tuscan Sangiovese that leans into elegance rather than excess. The nose opens with ripe red cherry, dried raspberry, and subtle floral notes, followed by hints of savory herbs, leather, and gentle spice. On the palate it is medium-bodied with bright acidity, finely grained tannins, and a balanced, food-driven structure that feels distinctly Tuscan.

\$16 Mourvèdre California (Santa Barbara Highlands)

Groundwork Mourvèdre, 2017

Features notes of dark cherry, black blackberry, pepper-crusted meats, leather, dried earth, and touches of dark chocolate or hibiscus tea.

Medium-to-full-bodied with fine tannins, rustic depth, and a balanced structure.

\$15 Touriga Franca, Tinta Amarela, Tinta Roriz, Rufete, Tinta Barroca, Malvasia Petra, Donzelinho Tinto

Portugal (Duoro)

Luis Seabra Vinhos, Xisto Ilimitado

Bright garnet. High toned red and blue fruit aromas, tinged with wet stone and violets. On the palate, lush, but with bright acidity to balance the red cherry and pomegranate fruit. White pepper, slate and herbal aromas overlay the core of fruit on a juicy, fresh finish.

\$16 Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot

France (Bordeaux)

La Gorce, Medoc Cru Bourgeois, 2020

Highly aromatic and expressive. It leads with prominent ripe red and black fruits, particularly strawberry, cherry, and sweet cassis. Swirling the glass unlocks complex underlying notes of peppery spice, licorice, earthy minerality, and a touch of orange zest, all subtly framed by toasted oak.

Wine Spritzers

Blood Orange Spritz

\$12/\$22 Pitcher

Lively and bittersweet with vibrant orange peel, herbs, and citrus zest. Fine bubbles lift bright botanicals, finishing crisp, slightly tart, and refreshingly dry. Classic aperitivo elegance.

Porto Tónico

A bright and breezy highball from the Douro to the Aegean. Crisp dry white port meets the delicate salinity and botanicals of Three Cents' Aegean Tonic for a refreshingly elegant aperitif with a coastal twist. Light, zesty, and effortlessly cool.
