SPARKLING WHITE

\$28 Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir

France (Champagne)

Champagne Collet Aÿ Brut, NV

Champagne Collet Brut is the distinctive cuvee and identity of Maison Collet, harmoniously combining

Champagne's three main grape varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. Light golden-amber color. Toasted brioche aromas with fine citrus notes. Powerful and full-bodied revealing great freshness and amazing length.

\$15 Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir France (Loire Valley)

May Georges Brut, Cremant de Loire

A soft, golden color with elegant bubbles. Green apple and brioche deliver a balance of fruit purity and richness to this sparkling favorite. Loire's own Chenin Blanc brings chamomile and lanolin, adding complexity to Chardonnay's fresh green apple and Pinot Noir's delicate cherry flavors. A vein of focused acidity runs through an otherwise creamy texture, and a kiss of residual sugar provides for a rounded mouthfeel.

\$13 Glera

Italy (Valdobbiadene)

Bortolomiol Prosecco Valdobbiadene Superiore Extra Dry, NV

In the glass it has a straw-yellow color, with some light reflections tending to gold and greenish. The perlage is thin and persistent. The aromas on the nose recount fruity and citrus scents, which blend well with notes of lily of the valley, hawthorn and aromatic herbs. Tasting is balanced, soft, extremely drinkable.

\$14 Mourvèdre South Africa (Swartland)

Intellego 'Hey Mila!' Pét-Nat Rosé, 2024

A glorious salmon pink pétillant naturel made from 100% Mourvedre. Mila is Jurgen's wife's niece and her bubbly personality as a 2.5 year old struck him when they stayed with them pre-wedding. Apart from hearing his wife complain about his style, her brother calling 'Hey Mila' was something he heard often and it grew on him to name this sparkling wine after her.

\$10 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

HoneyBubbles, NV

The palate offers bubbling mousse flourishing with sweet citrus and tangerine, honey, peaches, white flowers and orange zest on the finish. The wine has an intriguing balance of sweetness and acidity providing structure.

\$12 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

Vietti, NV

An intense aroma of ripe yellow fruit (peaches, apricots, pears), floral notes (rose petals) and refined exotic spices (freshly cut ginger). The sweetness is balanced with a crisp, and refreshing acidity.

SPARKLING ROSE/RED

\$16 Lambrusco Salamino Italy (Emilia-Romagna)
Paltrinieri, Solco, Lambrusco della'Emilia, NV
This Lambrusco della'Emilia from Emilia-Romagna, Italy, offers a vibrant deep red color, showcasing its fine perlage. The nose is filled with intense notes of ripe fruits, including cherries, sour cherries, and blackberries, accompanied by floral scents that add complexity and depth. On the palate, this Lambrusco Salamino is pleasantly delicate, with good and balanced acidity.

\$19 Pinot Noir France (Jura)
Domaine Désiré Cremant de Jura Brut Rose, NV
Domaine Désiré Petit Crémant du Jura Brut Rosé is a super-limited, 100% Pinot Noir sparkling wine from the Jura region of eastern France. Cultivated from organic vineyards in Pupillin and Arbois, it delivers elegant aromas of red berries, orange zest, and a bone-dry, creamy finish.

\$13 Malvasia di Schierano, Malvasia Lunga Nero (Off-dry, pink/red)
Italy (Piedmont)
Bava Rosetta, Malvasia Di Castelnuovo Don Bosco, NV
Cherry red in color with a little crown. Bouquet of wild rose and strawberries, sweet and balanced while the tannins are just slightly perceptible leaving intact the

pleasantness of the wine. Natural and lively with a balanced palate.

STILL WHITE

\$12 Vinho Verde

Portugal (Alentejo)

J Portugal Ramos Vila Santa Vinho White

João Portugal Ramos (J Portugal Ramos) produces a crisp and elegant Vinho Verde Loureiro. This lively white offers bright citrus and floral aromas, underscored by pronounced minerality and a long, refreshing finish.

\$13 Garganega, Trebbiano, Trebbianello, Cortese, Manzoni Bianco Italy (Veneto)

Corte Gardoni Custoza, 2021

We love it partly because of the Piccoli family's infectious devotion to their region's local grape varieties—Garganega, Trebbiano, Trebbianello, Cortese, and Manzoni Bianco—you can also just love it at face value. With notes of ripe apple and citrus zest, it's an effortless and delicious sipper.

\$17 Sauvignon Blanc California (Napa Valley)

Cliff Rede Sauvignon Blanc, 2023

The lovable 2023 vintage of this Sauvignon Blanc offers complex hints of lime sherbet, honeysuckle, lemon curd, and orange blossom that are fragrant and

complex. The flavors and aromas are built on a fleshy, succulent frame, with notes of nectarine, pear, and ripe honeydew melon. Harmonious with a thread of acidity on the finish, this vibrant wine dazzles with its refreshing appeal.

\$12 Semillon, Malvasia of Lazio Italy (Lazio)
Appia Antica 400, Lazio Bianco I.G.T., 2022

The wine is brilliant, with a beautiful straw yellow color. Consistent on the nose, very intense, complex, with fruity notes of pear and citrus, exotic and floral fruit. On the palate it is dry, fresh, rightly acid with a typical flavor and minerality of the territory, persistent in the mouth, intense, harmonious and elegant. The Semillon finds in these volcanic territories a very particular personality That it allows to best express its mineral and fresh characteristics.

\$18 Chardonnay Argentina (Mendoza)
Zorzal Gran Terroir Chardonnay, 2022

This boutique, sustainably farmed Chardonnay presents a complex mineral profile with notes of crushed wet rock, green apple, orange peel, and subtle hints of baked bread. It is fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged for 12 months in 500L French oak barrels and concrete.

STILL ROSE & ORANGE (SKIN-CONTACT)

\$13 Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah, Rolle France
(Provence)

Chateau Gassier Provence Rosé, 2024

Pale color with white nectarine highlights. On the nose, notes of white-eshed fruit (peach, nectarine), citrus (Corsican clementine) and exotic fruit and balanced on the palate between tension and roundness, with delicate notes of white-eshed fruit and citrus zest.

\$16 Garganega

Italy (Noto)

Cantina Marilina Sikele Grecanico Orange Wine, 2024

Amber-hued with aromas of almond, straw, and lemon, the palate is savory, structured, and bright. Subtle tannins and lively acidity make this wine both elegant and wild—juicy, dry, and slightly saline with a soft mineral edge.

CORAVIN REDS

\$30 Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Merlot
Beaulieu Vineyard, Tapestry Reserve Red

A layered and lightly chewy red with currant, orange peel and hints of hazelnut. Fine tannins. Some pine, cedar, graphite, black currant and iodine. Perfumed.

Tannins turn fine and bright. Excellent length and serious tension.

\$24 Merlot, Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon Ornellaia estate, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia, 2021

With its signature ruby red hue and purple tinges, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia displays lively red fruit aromas alongside light spiciness. The wine is well balanced across all components on the palate, blending smooth tannins with refreshing acidity that lends crunchiness to this enjoyable wine

STILL RED

\$12 Mavrud, Rubin Bulgaria (Thracian Valley)

CHILLED!

Edoardo Miroglio, Bio Red Blend, NV

Intense and vivid ruby colour. Complex and fresh fruity nose with red fruit nuances: blackcurrant, cherry and blackberry, elegantly balanced with the oak.

Distinctive typical aromas of the indigenous grape varieties. The taste is elegant and well balanced. Rich fruity flavour, well balanced acidity and tannins.

\$13 Tempranillo

Spain (La Mancha)

**Bodegas Volver La Mancha Single Vineyard
Tempranillo, 2022**

This has aromas of black fruit, blueberries, dried oysters, grilled herbs and mushrooms. Its full-bodied with firm, fine tannins. Savory and structured with excellent energy.

\$17 Pinot Noir Burgundy (France)

**Dominique Gruhier Bourgogne Epineuil
Pinot Noir, 2023**

On the nose, the wine opens with bright red fruit aromas of wild cherry, raspberry, and red currant. These primary notes are layered with subtle violet and rose petals and floral nuances. As the wine evolves in the glass, it reveals earthy undertones of forest floor, wet stone, and a delicate hint of spice, such as white pepper and clove.

\$13 Barbera, Dolcetto, Cabernet Sauvignon Italy
(Piemonte)

Buongiorno Tacchino Rosso, 2019

Dark cherry, cranberry, and slate on the nose are joined by hints of white blossom and smoke. The palate boasts well-integrated acidity and bright, delicious fruit (drinking more like a 13% wine than the 14% listed) with a pleasing, long-lasting finish.

**\$17 Zinfandel, Carignane, Grenache, Mourvèdre,
Chenin Blanc**

California (Dry Creek Valley)

Extradimensional Wine Co. Yeah!, Go Rick Red!, 2021

The 2021 Go Rick Red! is a wine of magical energy! The perfume is a garland of herb dusted cool cherries, satsuma peel, five spice, and intrigue. The palate is a wonderful pop of fruit and spice that feels like pure summer solstice sorcery!

\$16 Syrah California (Paso Robles) Erble Vines Syrah, 2022

Medium in intensity and body, this Syrah shines with aromas of tobacco and herbaceous notes of olive and clove. Flavors of blackberry, black cherry, and more notably hot cedar sauna are stunning on the mid-palate. Coffee, tobacco, and earthy notes round out the back of the palate.

\$18 Cabernet Sauvignon

USA, California (Paso Robles)

Eberle, Vineyard Selection Cabernet Sauvignon, 2023

Crafted from the exceptional 2023 vintage, one of the finest growing seasons in recent memory, this Cabernet Sauvignon showcases vibrant layers of black cherry, cassis, and tobacco leaf. Hints of cocoa and brûlée add depth and richness. The palate is structured with firm, fine tannins, lifted by juicy acidity and finishing dry and elegantly balanced. A standout wine from an extraordinary year.

Wine Spritzers

Blood Orange Spritz

\$12/\$22 Pitcher

Lively and bittersweet with vibrant orange peel, herbs, and citrus zest. Fine bubbles lift bright botanicals, finishing crisp, slightly tart, and refreshingly dry. Classic aperitivo elegance.

Porto Tónico

A bright and breezy highball from the Douro to the Aegean. Crisp dry white port meets the delicate salinity and botanicals of Three Cents' Aegean Tonic for a refreshingly elegant aperitif with a coastal twist. Light, zesty, and effortlessly cool.
