SPARKLING WHITE

\$28 Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir

France (Champagne)

Champagne Collet Aÿ Brut, NV

Champagne Collet Brut is the distinctive cuvee and identity of Maison Collet, harmoniously combining Champagne's three main grape varieties: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. Light golden-amber color. Toasted brioche aromas with fine citrus notes. Powerful and full-bodied revealing great freshness and

amazing length.

\$16 Grüner Veltliner Austria (Österreichischer)
Szigeti Sektkellerei Grüner Veltliner, NV

Szigeti seeks to produce wines in a fresh style with clear varietal expression. Grüner Veltliner Brut shows notes of green apple and citrus with the savory spiciness typical of the Grüner Veltliner variety. The wine is crisp and clean tasting on the palate with a lingering dry finish.

\$13 Chardonnay France (Vin de France)

Antoine Muller Blanc de Blancs Brut, NV

On the nose, it presents a delicate bouquet of green apple, white peach, and citrus blossoms, underscored by subtle hints of brioche and minerality. The palate is vibrant and crisp, showcasing flavors of zesty lemon, ripe pear, and a touch of almond, all balanced by a harmonious acidity. The finish is clean and lingering, leaving a delightful impression of fresh fruit and toasty nuances.

\$16 Montonega Spain (Catalunya)

Can Sumoi Ancestral Montonega, NV

Green apple flesh, white floral, yeast, white fruits on the notes. Dry style. It was aged four months under the ancestral method. With a modest varietal aromatic profile and a light citrus note, the palate is bright and

delicate with rustic bubbles, lively freshness and low alcohol (10.5%).

\$10 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

HoneyBubbles, NV

The palate offers bubbling mousse flourishing with sweet citrus and tangerine, honey, peaches, white flowers and orange zest on the finish. The wine has an intriguing balance of sweetness and acidity providing structure.

\$12 Moscato Italy (Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G.)

Vietti, NV

An intense aroma of ripe yellow fruit (peaches, apricots, pears), floral notes (rose petals) and refined exotic spices (freshly cut ginger). The sweetness is balanced with a crisp, and refreshing acidity.

SPARKLING ROSE

\$14 Pinot Noir Washington (Columbia Valley)

Treveri Cellars, Morimoto Dream Brut Rose

Nice and light effervescence. Mix of small and large bubbles. Green apple and pear on the nose. Very mineral forward with sweet petroleum, sea water, and some lemon peel. It opens up with a little time to have some light floral perfume notes.

\$13 Lambrusco di Sorbara, Grasparossa

Italy (Emilia Romagna)

Cleto Chiarli, Vecchia Modena, NV

Medium pink in colour. Tangy cherry yogurt and cherry blossom with fresh acidity and herbal lift. Just a touch of residual sugar rounds out the palate but it still tastes dry – just texturally creamy with fine bubbles.

\$13 Malvasia di Schierano, Malvasia Lunga Nero (Off-dry, pink/red)

Italy (Piedmont)

Bava Rosetta, Malvasia Di Castelnuovo Don Bosco, NV

Cherry red in color with a little crown. Bouquet of wild rose and strawberries, sweet and balanced while the tannins are just slightly perceptible leaving intact the pleasantness of the wine. Natural and lively with a balanced palate.

STILL WHITE

\$15 Muscat Vert

California (Russian River Valley)

Emme Wines, The Sun Egg, 2023

‘the sun egg’ is a book by Swedish author Elsa Beskow, about an elf who finds an orange in the woods. This wine is aromatic, with notes of peach, honey, with

delicious layers of orange peel with a crisp acidity and an intriguing sweet character.

\$13 Pinot Gris Washington (Columbia Valley)

Dusted Valley, Boomtown, 2023

It's like Pinot Gris and Viognier had a love child. The wine's orange and passion fruit aromas intersect with notes of wet slate and lavender water. Soft acidity caresses flavors like pineapple, green tea and chamomile flowers. This is a light-bodied, satisfying wine that should be sipped at will.

\$15 Sauvignon Blanc California (Sonoma County)

Quivira Vineyards, VI. 2021

Flinty and crisp, this inviting, medium-bodied wine shows lots of mineral, white pepper, chalk and cucumber flavors while great acidity keeps it lively in texture.

\$17 Roussanne, Chardonnay USA (California)

Stolpman Vineyards, Uni, 2021

This wine is crisp and zippy, but with a full, creamy texture. Bursting with green apple, stone fruit, and marine minerality, this is the perfect companion for sushi.

\$14 Chardonnay New Zealand (Kumeu)

Kumeu Village Chardonnay, 2024

A blend of Auckland and Hawkes Bay fruit, this is already approachable, with some subtle red apple and ripe white-fleshed stonefruit. Lovely ripeness and although lean and sleek there's plenty of flavour. Aromas and flavors of fresh and cooked apples with hints of vanilla and cream. It's medium-bodied with lemon and lime highlights and crisp acidity. A touch of flint at the end.

STILL ROSE & ORANGE (SKIN-CONTACT)

\$15 Touriga Nacional Portugal (Duoro)

Olé & Obrigado, Touriga Nacional Em Rosé

Saturated rose-pink. On the nose, fresh crushed strawberries, bing cherries and cherry blossom aromas leap from the glass. On the palate, juicy and fresh, with beautiful texture and balance. Sour and Bing cherry, fresh and macerated strawberries, and a touch of white pepper spice all in abundance.

\$12 Macabeo (Viura)

Spain (Murcia)

Ninja de Las Uvas, Julia Casado, 2020

It is hot down in Murcia and the grapes get a lovely ripeness. Reds have fleshy dark fruits, and this delightful orange, picked slightly early has a distinctive floral and citrus fruit note alongside the dry grippyness of the skin contact. Julia makes super wine which are great fun to drink but the quality is also very high.

CORAVIN REDS

\$30 Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Merlot

Beaulieu Vineyard, Tapestry Reserve Red

A layered and lightly chewy red with currant, orange peel and hints of hazelnut. Fine tannins. Some pine, cedar, graphite, black currant and iodine. Perfumed. Tannins turn fine and bright. Excellent length and serious tension.

\$24 Merlot, Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon **Ornellaia estate, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia, 2021**

With its signature ruby red hue and purple tinges, Le Volte dell'Ornellaia displays lively red fruit aromas alongside light spiciness. The wine is well balanced across all components on the palate, blending smooth tannins with refreshing acidity that lends crunchiness to this enjoyable wine

STILL RED

\$12 Mavrud, Rubin Bulgaria (Thracian Valley)

CHILLED!

Edoardo Miroglio, Bio Red Blend, NV

Intense and vivid ruby colour. Complex and fresh fruity nose with red fruit nuances: blackcurrant, cherry and

blackberry, elegantly balanced with the oak. Distinctive typical aromas of the indigenous grape varieties. The taste is elegant and well balanced. Rich fruity flavour, well balanced acidity and tannins.

\$13 Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Barroca
Portugal (Douro)

Symington, Altano Tinto Red Douro, 2022

In the glass, this shows a deep crimson color with purple edges. The nose opens with lifted floral notes layered over fresh red fruit of cherry, red plum, and raspberry, followed by subtle spice. On the palate, it is smooth and well-shaped, combining juicy red fruit with a silky mid-palate and fine, ripe tannins. The finish is clean and lightly savory, with gentle spice and freshness carrying through.

\$19 Pinot Nero Italy (Roddi)

Langhe, Gian Luca, Pinot Nero 2021

An explosion of small crunchy fruits, currants and dried flowers, many herbaceous notes, fresh aromatic herbs, light smoky note, white pepper. Very fresh mouthfeel and high acidity, but perfectly integrated, subtle tannins, with notable persistence.

\$16 Sangiovese Italy (Chianti)

Cafaggio, Chianti Classico Riserva, 2019

Cherries, raspberries and chocolate are contrasted with metallic, earthy notes of pencil shavings and soil on the nose, with the graphite aromas providing a through line to a palate that's almost quartz-like with salty, acidic notes and the snap of fresh cherry skin.

\$13 Grenache Noir, Syrah, Mourvedre

France (Rhone Valley)

Domaine Gabriel Monier, Cotes du Rhone

Ruby red color. The aromas come in waves of wild blackberry, a hint of cranberry and then earth. Well balanced full body. More rich berry flavors, a little oak and then hints of soy sauce.

\$15 Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah Oregon (Dundee)

Maison Noir, Horseshoes and Handgrenades, NV

Horseshoes & Handgrenades is fruit-driven, full-bodied complex red blend sourced from Southern Oregon and Red Mountain Washington. The rich, ripe, voluptuous fruit comes from Oregon Syrah with just enough Washington Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot to give it complexity and structure. Think cherry pits and leather!

\$18 Cabernet Sauvignon

USA, California (Paso Robles)

Eberle, Vineyard Selection Cabernet

Sauvignon, 2023

Crafted from the exceptional 2023 vintage one of the finest growing seasons in recent memory this Cabernet Sauvignon showcases vibrant layers of black cherry, cassis, and tobacco leaf. Hints of cocoa and brûlée add depth and richness. The palate is structured with firm, fine tannins, lifted by juicy acidity and finishing dry and elegantly balanced. A standout wine from an extraordinary year.

Blood Orange Spritz

\$12/\$22 Pitcher

Lively and bittersweet with vibrant orange peel, herbs, and citrus zest. Fine bubbles lift bright botanicals, finishing crisp, slightly tart, and refreshingly dry. Classic aperitivo elegance.

Porto Tónico

\$13/\$24 Pitcher

A bright and breezy highball from the Douro to the Aegean. Crisp dry white port meets the delicate salinity and botanicals of Three Cents' Aegean Tonic for a refreshingly elegant aperitif with a coastal twist. Light, zesty, and effortlessly cool.
